Policies for Personal Data Protection Subject to GDPR

Sumika-kakoushi Co., Ltd. (hereinafter the "Company") hereby undertakes to observe the information controller's duties set forth in the General Data Protection Regulation (hereinafter "GDPR") of the European Union (hereinafter "EU") and handle collected personal data appropriately and rigidly as per the policies set forth therein.

1. Collection of Personal Data

The Company may collect customers' personal data through customers' use of our website and through the course of our business operations. The Company will handle the collected personal data in conformity to the GDPR as applicable. Especially, sensitive personal data such as religious beliefs and health conditions will be handled as per the special standards set forth in the GDPR.

Mainly, personal data handled by the Company includes but is not limited to:

name, address, phone number, affiliations, e-mail address, history of browsing in the Company's website, and IP address, etc.

2. Purposes of Use and Handling of Personal Data

(1)The Company will use personal data for the purposes listed below:

- To respond to inquiries about the Company's products and any matters related to the Company
- To operate and improve the Company's website
- To perform analysis, planning, and statistics for the Company's sales activities
- To conduct analysis and testing requested by business partners and customers and report the results thereof
- To exercise and perform rights and duties based on agreements with business partners and customers

(2)The Company will announce in advance any intended use of personal data for any purpose not listed above.

(3)You will be deemed consenting to the handling of your personal data by the Company upon your provision of personal data. Although the Company will handle your personal data based on this consent, you may withdraw the consent at any time.

Please withhold your personal data when you do not agree with the Company's handling of personal data.

3. Retention Period

The Company will retain collected personal data as long as any need for such data for the intended purposes exists, but will promptly dispose of the data by appropriate means when such need no longer exists.

4. Non-disclosure to Third Party

The Company will not disclose or provide collected personal data without the principal's consent unless permitted to do so as an exception by applicable laws and regulations such as the GDPR.

5. Correction and Disposal of Personal Data

Principals of personal data have the right to (1) check, (2) correct, (3) add, delete, and exercise data portability rights for, and (4) request limitation of data treatment, as well as to extend a protest to handling of personal data by the Company.

6. Guarantee of Accuracy

The Company makes efforts to keep personal data current and modify and correct any inaccuracies or missing information.

7. Security Measures

When handling personal data, the Company takes appropriate technical and organizational measures to ensure appropriate security (e.g. protection against unauthorized and illegal processing, incidental loss, disposal, and corruption).

8. Handling of Personal Data of Persons under 16 Years of Age

The Company protects personal data of persons under 16 years of age as it does for adults'. Please be aware that we may require the consent of guardians for the provision of personal data of persons under 16 years of age.

9. Revision of the Policies

These policies are subject to change as necessary to protect personal data and comply with any amended laws and regulations.
